Review of Minutes: The minutes were provided for review and will need to be approved at the March meeting.

Admin Update: Mr. Carson recognized our parent volunteers, and business and community partners; and thanked them for their contributions to Three Oaks Middle. He stated that it is because of the involvement of our volunteers and partners that we are able to maintain our Florida Department of Education Five Star School status and the Golden School Award. Guests introduced themselves and shared information about how they contribute their time, services, and/or programs to the school and community. Mr. Carson also announced that the student test scores are official for 2014-2015 and Three Oaks Middle School has again been recognized as an A+ School.

School Improvement Plan (SIP): Mid-Year Review: Christy Moore provided an update of the SIP Mid-Year Reflection for 2015-2016.



100% of core subject area teachers will track standards and progress monitor through CASTLE.

Progress- As of January 4, 2016, all core subject area teachers have been trained. This is documented in Departmental PLC Minutes. All core subject area teachers are to input assessment data on individual standards into CASTLE on the weeks a District Checkpoint is not administered.

Teacher Engagement will increase by .2% in the area of, “My mission or purpose of my organization makes me feel that my job is important”, as stated on the Gallup Survey from the Lee County School District.

Progress- After completing a Google Form Survey rating the statement 1 to 5 (one being the lowest), our average is 3.59. This is an increase from a 3.39 last year.

One additional goal has been added to the SIP due to a safety concern:

100% of the student body, parents, and community will be aware of safety during parent pick up and drop off.

Progress- The PTO has discussed this matter, a letter writing campaign to local interested parties is currently underway, and a meeting has been held with district transportation about the possibility of installing a flashing light at the entrance.
