Board Member Comment

Mrs. Dozier informed members of the following:

Financial Services Executive Director Susan Malay handed out a draft of the Request for Qualification Selection Process. The draft has been reviewed and compared by twenty different districts and governmental entities.

Suggestions

- Make sure we invite everybody (business community) to a final meeting and go over the
 document once finalized so everyone has an understanding of what their expectations are.
- Heavy on administrators and no involvement with the community.
 - o Ask individual board members who could constructively participate
 - Disagreement with including community in the selection process conflict of interest. Suggested community be a part of design process but not selection.
- Add intent of how the seven optional members are selected.
- Having selection committee consist of twelve people instead of 7-10
- Having an odd number of members on selection committee
- Possibly having an elected official choose community member
- Advisory committee to determine which member will attend selection process.
- Someone from a building department of a city or county
- Add another section for "on time and on budget"

Suggestions Continued

After book reviews are conducted and the proposals are scored there will be a short list of top ranked vendors to be invited to give a presentation. Procurement would like the committee members to provide feedback on changes to the language, scoring and/or weight/points allocations. Procurement will be doing one thing differently, they are recommending to not average the book score with the presentation score. Start at zero points for the presentation and then the presentation will determine the winning score.
