Review and Approval of Agenda and Previous Month’s Meeting Minutes

Board Member Report

Mrs. Morgan noted that the Strategic Plan K-12 introduced in 2017 is showing evidence/results from FY18 and FY19 that the plan is working, as we are seeing student learning gains. Mrs. Morgan will provide details on some of the areas of improvement so they can be included as links for committee members to review.

An area of need is to focus on Pre-K due to children entering Kindergarten without the vocabulary, communication skills, and State expectations that are in place for Kindergarten students. Areas of concern are literacy/language skills, among others.

Another area of intense focus is on students entering the workforce after graduation and how the District can support this group of students in college and career readiness. The current programs are being reviewed with an emphasis on ensuring that all zones have the same access to these programs and certification areas.

The JROTC program in the District has been instrumental in elevating the leadership skills of students.

The sales tax has contributed to the investment of resources to assist with improving the career education programs at the high schools and technical colleges.

EnVision 2030 Community Event Work

Committee members worked in groups to determine which of the EnVision 2030 Long-Term Objectives and Related Goals would be most appropriate for discussion during the upcoming event.

Results from discussion:

- I.c. - Increase Mathematics proficiency to be the highest of Florida's 10 largest districts.
- I.e. – Decrease the achievement gaps between student groups in English/Language Arts & Math.
- I.f. – Increase the percentage of students who perceive there is an adult in their school who cares about them. (2)
- II.a. – Increase the percentage of Pre-K students identified as prepared for kindergarten.
- II.c. – Increase the number of elementary schools participating in the community PK articulation program.
- II.e. – Increase funding raised for Pre-K expansion projects.
- III.a. – Increase graduation rate.
- III.c. – Increase the percentage of students graduating with at least one industry certification. (2)
- III.d. – Increase the number of business & community partners involved in Career & Technical Education Programs and initiatives. (2)
- IV.a. – Decrease turnover for school-based instructional personnel. (3)
- IV.b. – Increase retention rate for instructional personnel average years 1-5 to 2nd among the 11 similarly-sized districts by 2025.
- V.e. – Complete construction projects within budget.
- V.s. – Complete sales tax referendum projects on schedule. (x)

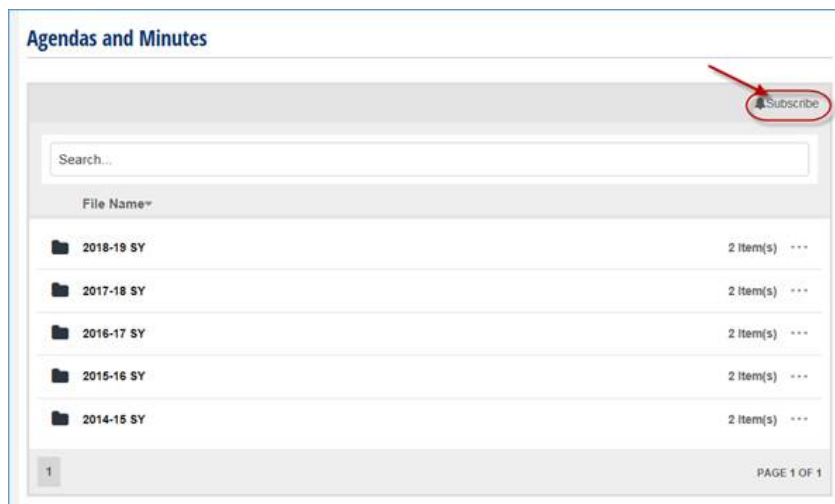
