# Candace Allevato -

- The committee gathered information from their school departments ninety-seven Spanish or French teachers across the district. Of the ninety-seven, 31% of them were part of the total textbook adoption which is huge representation.
- October 29<sup>th</sup>, World Language Department Head meeting it was part of the process that evening to have an opportunity to talk across schools.
- Minutes were captured during their PLC meeting. Other teachers said that they had open conversations, as it pertained to the entire department, so it varied from schools to schools.
