## Dear Three Oaks Middle School Families:

I am writing to share some important information regarding new security measures in place at our school. The School District has installed a doorbell access system with a security camera at the front entrance of the main office. This new system will require you to show your identification to the camera to gain access to the office. Beginning this Friday, March 29, 2019 the main office door will be locked during school hours. You will be required to show identification to be buzzed into the office. Please follow the procedure below:

Hold your driver's license, state issued photo identification, or passport up to the camera.

A staff member will ask for your name and purpose for your visit.

Once buzzed into the office, you will show your ID to a staff member at the desk to sign in your student, pick up your student for dismissal, or receive a visitor's badge.

To sign out a student for dismissal, visit a student for lunch, or speak with a student in the office, you must be listed on the child's emergency card on file.

We appreciate your patience as we implement this new security measure. The safety of our students and staff is our first priority. Should you have any questions, please feel free to call the school at 239-267-5757.

Este nuevo sistema requerirá que muestre su identificación a la cámara para obtener acceso a la oficina. Para firmar a un estudiante de salida temprano, visitar a un estudiante para almorzar o hablar con un estudiante en la oficina, su nombre debe de estar listado en la tarjeta de emergencia archivada del niño.
