Administration Report: Dr. Clark

 - Dr. Clark informed the PTO is not statutorily required to have a SAC representative, but when the position is filled, the person should represent the school demographically
 - $\circ~$ 40% of the school is Hispanic, and Dr. Clark would like to see bilingual help within the PTO
