# Administration Report: Dr. Clark and Mr. Barta

- Contract-tracing information can be gathered in 1-hour due to seating assignments and communication efforts in place, which helps avoid full-class quarantines
- 183 students are returning from Lee Home Connect to F2F for the second quarter
- The school will be at 80% capacity, with 280 remaining Lee Home Connect students
- Class sizes will increase; all desk shields are distributed, with more on back order
- One-way hallways will remain in place
- A survey was sent out to staff, students, and parents, asking for evaluation and feedback on current school atmosphere, with 697 returned to date:
  - Students and staff are feeling the stress of the different way of teaching and learning, but parents report higher rates of satisfaction
