- Threat made last week admin sent notificiation Student staff safety #1 priority made sure everyone was safe that day and campus would remain safe – worked with LCSO – unfortunately not even a TOMS student – someone had his username and password – that student is now facing the consequences – making sure the wrongly accused student is welcomed on campus
- October 14th EOQ, no school October 15th Professional Duty Day, October 18th schoolwide off-campus evacuation with support from LCSO going across the street to the park 1,000+ students cross Three Oaks Pkwy – will be shut down LCSO
- Should PTO contact wrongly accused student? It could open up PTO to then feel the need to address the student Dr. Barta suggested perhaps individual students and families can send in support? His class is planning on doing something to get together for this class PTO does not want to post anything on social media

- Amy Ospina no income or expense since last meeting balance just over \$10,000 minus silent auction staff allocation just over \$6,000 for PTO balance waiting on August "Culver's" spirit night check; may take a bit longer, coming from corporate office; Gabriel will follow-up if we don't receive a check by a certain timeframe; Lori will let us know when it comes in Texas Roadhouse was great for September; just under \$300 those are out two incoming earnings PTO is offering to help out with Q1 Honor Roll assembly usually about \$200-\$250 quarterly.
